


NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

A public meeting of the Board of Directors (the "Board") of the Noah Webster Schools-Pima, an Arizona non-profit corporation (the "Corporation" or the "School"), was held in the school's IT Room at 5399 N. Pima Rd, Scottsdale, Arizona at 4:30 p.m. A quorum being present, and the meeting having been duly noticed and called, the meeting was called to order.

1. Call to Order

Director Tomasson called the Meeting to Order

2. Approve the Minutes of the January 8, 2019 Board Meeting

A motion was made by Director R. Miller to approve the minutes for the meeting as presented. Director BJ Pennington seconded the motion.

Director Tomasson, Director Pennington, Director Wales, Director R. Miller, and Director S. Miller all voted in favor of approving the minutes as presented.

3. Principal Report

2019 Academic Benchmarks to Date

Principal Robert Rodenbaugh provided the Board with copies of Galileo Data Reports produced by The Center for Student Achievement and Benchmark #3 Comparison Data compiled in-house. Discussions took place regarding the increase, decrease and maintenance of certain scores and individual teacher performance.

Principal Rodenbaugh then discussed the issues that he has been experiencing with the 6<sup>th</sup> grade students at Pima. He informed the Board that he is going to have each of the 6<sup>th</sup> grade teachers take on teaching separate subjects to both classes. One teacher will teach Math to both and the other ELA to both, then they can do their other classes as usual. He feels that the change will be more engaging for the students and allow the teachers to better prepare engaging lessons for the students.

2020 Updates and Changes

Principal Rodenbaugh presented the Board with information on the research and work that both he and the Mesa Principal have been doing to help alleviate the issues being seen in 6<sup>th</sup> grade with lack of student engagement and the difficulty finding teachers able to teach all subject matter at that grade level. They have been working out schedules and reviewing current curriculum to enable both schools to departmentalize the 6<sup>th</sup> grade for the 2020 school year.

This would allow teachers to specialize in certain program areas making planning much easier but also allow for more creativity and engagement. Students would be able to change classes and have different teachers for the various subjects. This would help prepare them for Jr. High and break the monotony of being in the same classroom all day.

4. Financial Reports for the Period Ending 12/31/19

Ms. Dry presented the Board with the Financial Statements, Budget to Actual Reports, Variance Discussion, CHAR55-1, CHAR64-1 and the supporting documents and information for the 12/31/19 reports.

Director Miller explained what S & P would be looking at for the 2019 review and discussed the many issues that we have to be aware of due to our declining enrollment. Vicki Dry reviewed some of the measures being taken to decrease expenses. Further discussion took place regarding the Financial Statements and the Budget to Actual Reports. Director Miller asked that an updated Withdrawal report and an update on the professional development being provided by The Center for Student Achievement be prepared and put on the Agenda for the next Board meeting.

The next Board meeting is set for Tuesday, April 9, 2019 at 4:30 at the Mesa Campus.
